

# Wilkes Tax Lists - Surname Report: Triplett

The sources for these taxpayer entries are explained in detail in the book "Wilkes County, NC, Tax Lists: 1797-1799" which is available from lulu.com and from me. The book also includes maps that show the locations of each tax district.

---

**1777 Surry**      *3 Surry districts cover most of present-day Wilkes. They are complete lists. Hardgrave's and Herndon's districts are from the William Lenoir Papers. Cleveland's district is from 1974 book.*

**Triplett, Mason**      Hardgrave's District; 0 acres; 0 improvements; 3 slaves; 2 horses; 6 cattle; £1 money; no interest; no stocks.

**Triplett, William**      Hardgrave's District; 0 acres; 2 improvements; 2 slaves; 5 horses; 16 cattle; no money; no interest; no stocks.

**1778 Wilkes**      *3 out of 10 districts have extant lists, and they are likely incomplete. They cover the southwest part of Wilkes and the waters of New River.*

**Triplett, Mason**      Foster's District, 0 improvements, 3 slaves (£170), 2 horses (£20), 8 cattle (£16), £2/11s money, £208/11s taxable property.

**Triplett, Wm.**      Foster's District, 2 improvements (£130), 2 slaves (£150), 6 horses (£36), 20 cattle (£40), £1 money, £357 taxable property.

**1779 Wilkes**      *4 out of 12 districts have extant lists. Allen's district might be complete. The other three (grouped as 'BSC') are in the western part of the county and are incomplete.*

**1782 Wilkes**      *12 out of 12 districts have extant lists. The list is complete and available as part of the NC Digital Collection (digital.ncdcr.gov) as call number GA 46.1.*

**Triplett, Eloner**      Sloan's District; 100 acres (£15); 1 slaves (0-7,50-60) (£20); 0 slaves (7-16,40-50); 0 slaves (16-40); 2 horses/mules (£12); 7 cattle (£7); £54 taxable property.

**Triplett, Mason (s)** Kees's District; 0 acres; 1 slaves (0-7,50-60) (£20); 1 slaves (7-16,40-50) (£40); 2 slaves (16-40) (£160); 3 horses/mules (£18); 3 cattle (£3); £241 taxable property.

1783 Wilkes *0 out of 12 districts have extant lists.*

---

1784 Wilkes *12 out of 12 districts have extant lists compiled from two sources. The Lenoir Papers list everyone, but no districts are given. Another copy is missing taxpayers in 3 districts (Cleveland's, Johnson's, and Sloan's), but it does assign districts to everyone else. Names listed without a district are likely from one of those three districts.*

**1798 Wilkes**      *No district lists have been found. The land quantities and descriptions were pulled from the 1798 Federal Direct Tax List. This is only a small portion of the information contained in that list which has details on houses, cabins, mills, barns, and other structures. That information has been compiled into a separate book.*

**1799 Wilkes**      *14 out of 19 districts have extant lists. The missing districts are Thurmond's, Dula's, Whittington's, E. Brown's, and Bunyard's. Additionally, Gwyn's district is incomplete.*
